The Sprouts Program Provides

- A rich early educational experience
- Literacy and language infused education
- Weekly forays into the community to learn new skills with local experts
- Maine state certified teachers
- Research-based instructional strategies and the High/Scope curriculum
- On-going screening and assessments to measure the skills children are gaining and to identify those who might be at risk of developing reading difficulties or other learning difficulties.



Sprouts Early Childhood Education Program

Our Sprouts program is a full-day, year round program which uses the nationally recognized, literacy-enriched High Scope curriculum to meet the individual developmental and educational goals of young children in a natural setting. There are no income guidelines to meet, and no residency requirements.

We provide a comprehensive range of educational and support services to families with young children ages 2.5 to 5. Children must be between 2.5 and 5 years old on October 15th of the current year to be eligible.

Our caring, qualified teachers plan their curriculum around each child's unique needs, interests and strengths.

Nature-based early childhood education combines the best aspects of hands-on learning and traditional literacy, language, numeracy and science education. Our natural exploration spaces are designed to stimulate and challenge children, and each day provides new opportunities for children to build on the skills learned the day before.
